There will be no sale at Fruitland (June 30; July 28)

Compared to last week, 300 lbs steers and 300-400 lbs heifers sold steady to \$1 higher, the rest of the offering sold \$5-8 lower. Slaughter cows \$2 sold \$1 lower and bulls sold \$2 lower; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 14 percent of the run, 86 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 26 percent of the offering, 64 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 17 percent.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1390-2200 lbs, bulk \$56.25-58.25, High Dressing \$62.50, Low Dressing \$53.50.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 3-7 yrs old, 830-1275 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$605-710.
