Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold \$1-5 higher on a limited test. Slaughter cows sold \$1 lower and bulls sold \$2 higher; Demand good and supply light. Cows made up approximately 26 percent of the run, 74 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 44 percent of the offering, 49 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 25 percent.

STOCKER COWS: Medium 1: Few 890-1005 lbs, \$67-75.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 3-7 yrs old 950-1360 2nd and 3rd stage \$975-1100.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: 3-7 yrs old, 1090-1400 lbs with 130-220 lbs calves, \$1150-1500 per pair. Δ
