

# Fruitland Livestock Market

**JUNE 3, 2008 • Fruitland, Mo.**

**Receipts: 362; Last Week: 403; Year Ago: 454**

Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold \$1-5 higher, on a very limited test. Slaughter cows sold \$1 higher and bulls sold \$3 higher; Demand moderate and supply light. Cows made up approximately 29 percent of the run, 71 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 31 percent of the offering, 45 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 18 percent.

**FEEDER STEERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 300-350 lbs \$110-125; 400-500 lbs \$110-122.50; 500-575 lbs \$108-119; few 650-700 lbs \$103-109. Medium 2: Few 425-500 lbs \$90-101.

**FEEDER HOLSTEINS:** Large 3: 350-400 lbs \$70.50-72.75; 400-475 lbs \$70-71.

**FEEDER HEIFERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 300-400 lbs

\$101-106; 450-500 lbs \$98-108.50; 500-600 lbs \$95-104.50; 650-675 lbs \$95-105; pkg 753 lbs \$93. Medium 2: 550-600 lbs \$85-92; few 600-675 lbs \$82-93.

**FEEDER BULLS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 700-750 lbs \$94.50-95; few 800-825 lbs \$75.50-78.50.

**SLAUGHTER COWS:** Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, \$54.50-59.25; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$55.25-59.50, High Dressing \$63.75-67.75, Low Dressing \$48; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$43-46.50, High Dressing \$49.75.

**SLAUGHTER BULLS:** Yield Grade 1-2: 1450-2135 lbs, bulk \$67.50-70, High Dressing \$73-75.

**REPLACEMENT COWS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 3-7 yrs old, 985-1315 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$630-810.

**COW-CALF PAIRS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 965-1280 lbs with 90-140 lbs calves, \$780-860.     Δ
