Receipts: 452; Last Week: 395; Year Ago: 811

Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold \$2-5 higher. Slaughter cows sold \$2 lower and bulls scarce; Demand moderate and supply light. Cows made up approximately 23 percent of the run, 77 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 42 percent of the offering, 46 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 23 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 350-400 lbs \$107-119; 400-500 lbs \$104-115; 500-575 lbs \$90.50-100; Fancy pkg 525 lbs \$101.50-104.50; few 600-650 lbs \$87.50-92.75. Medium 2: 425-500 lbs \$91-98.50; 500-600 lbs \$80-94; 600-675 lbs \$79-85.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 300-400 lbs \$89-96; 400-500 lbs \$87-98; 500-600 lbs \$82-92; few 600-

700 lbs \$80-84; fancy pkg 621 lbs \$95. Medium 2: Few 350-400 lbs \$78-85.50; few 500-550 lbs \$75.50-80.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 550-600 lbs \$80.25-87; few 625-700 lbs \$80.50-87.50; few 700-750 lbs \$78-80.50.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$42.25-43.75, High Dressing \$46.50; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$40.50-44.50, High Dressing \$46.50, Low Dressing \$37.50; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$34.50-36.25.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Scarce.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 3-7 yrs old, 925-1305 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$660-770.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: few 4-6 yrs old, 970-1010 lbs, with 60-140 lbs calves, \$670-730 per pair.
