Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold steady to \$4 lower. Slaughter cows sold \$2 lower and bulls sold \$1 lower; Demand and supply light. Cows made up approximately 28 percent of the run, 72 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 48 percent of the offering, 43 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 33 percent.
