Receipts: 272; Last Week: 757; Year Ago: 530

Compared to last week, steer and heifers sold uneven, from \$3 higher to \$3 lower on a very light test due to flooding. Slaughter cows sold \$3 higher and bulls not tested; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 31 percent of the run, 69 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 45 percent of the offering, 49 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 13 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 265 lbs \$172; few 350-375 lbs \$146-158; few 400-500 lbs \$135.50-153; 500-550 lbs \$136-147; few 600-700 lbs \$124-135.50. Medium 2: Pkg 265 lbs \$133; few 350-400 lbs \$135-140; few 425-500 lbs \$125-144.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 278 lbs \$144; few 300-375 lbs \$130.50-143; few 400-450 lbs \$135-

145; few 450-500 lbs \$126-138; 525-600 lbs \$124.50-131. Medium 2: Pkg 345 lbs \$132; few 400-450 lbs \$120; pkg 775 lbs \$100-100.50.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 550-575 lbs \$121-126; pkg 715 lbs \$107.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$77.50-79, High Dressing \$81.75-85.25; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$72.25-78.50, High Dressing \$80-84.50, Low Dressing \$67; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$60-65, High Dressing \$70-72.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Scarce.

STOCKER COWS: Scarce.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium 2: Few 4-5 yrs old 870-1025 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage \$880-910. 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 845-1050 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$780-790.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Scarce.
