Receipts: 490; Last Week: No Sale; Year Ago: 478

Due to the Holidays there was no sale the past two weeks for a trend comparison, however there were undertones of \$2-4 higher in the steers offering, heifers sold \$1-4 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$1 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 23 percent of the run, 77 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 72 percent of the offering, 19 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 60 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 350-400 lbs \$103.50-105.50; 400-500 lbs \$95-104; 500-550 lbs \$95.50-104; few 575-600 lbs \$85.25-86.50; 600-650 lbs \$88.25-93.50; 650-700 lbs \$80-88.50; 725-800 lbs \$82-89.75; 800-900 lbs \$80-88.25; pkg 1037 lbs \$70. Medium 2: Few 350-400 lbs \$88-95.50; few 425-450 lbs \$86.50-90; few 500-525 lbs \$82.50-85.25.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 400-500

lbs \$83.25-87.75; 500-600 lbs \$79.50-83.25; pkg 623 lbs \$74.75. Medium 2: Few 500-600 lbs \$70-78; few 600-650 lbs \$70-75.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 600-650 lbs \$80-86.25; pkg 787 lbs \$69.25. Medium 2: Pkg 503 lbs \$84.50; few 600-625 lbs \$75-75.50.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$40-44, High Dressing few \$45-46; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$39.50-45, High Dressing few \$47.25-48.50, Low Dressing \$34; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$36.50-39.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1415-2290 lbs, bulk \$49-54.50, High Dressing \$61.50.

STOCKER COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Scarce.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 5-7 yrs old, 905-1310 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$610-650. 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 850-1325 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$460-560.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Scarce. Δ
