Compared to last week, 600 lbs heifers sold steady, the rest of the offering sold \$3-6 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold steady; Demand and supply light. Cows made up approximately 24 percent of the run, 76 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 39 percent of the offering, 59 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 27 percent.
