Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold steady to \$3 higher. Slaughter cows sold steady, bulls sold \$2 higher; Demand and supply moderate. Cows made up approximately 34 percent of the run, 66 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 49 percent of the offering, 44 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 17 percent.
