Receipts: 987; Last Week: 655; Year Ago: 517

Compared to last week, 300-400 lbs steers sold \$2-4 higher, the rest of the offering sold steady to \$4 lower. Slaughter cows sold \$1 higher and bulls sold steady; Demand uneven and supply moderate. Cows made up approximately 34 percent of the run, 66 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 44 percent of the offering, 43 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 22 percent.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1405-2705 lbs, bulk \$56.50-61.75, High Dressing \$64-65.25.

STOCKER COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 3-5 yrs, 805-1125 lbs, \$55-61.25.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 3-6 yrs old, 985-1320 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$720-915.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: 4-6 yrs old, 945-1250 lbs with 70-185 lbs calves, \$850-1050 per pair. Δ
