Compared to last week, feeder steers sold \$1-2 lower and heifers sold steady. Slaughter cows and bulls were steady. Demand and supply was light. Cow calf pairs were scarce with a few scattered single entries. Cows made up approximately 20 percent of the offering, 80 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 44 percent of the offering, 56 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled 36 percent
