Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold \$4-11 lower on a limit test. Slaughter cows sold steady, bulls \$3 higher; Demand and supply very light. Cows made up approximately 16 percent of the run, 84 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 43 percent of the offering, 43 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 18 percent.
