**Receipts: 733; Last Week: No Sale; Year Ago: 507**

Due to the Holidays there was no sale last week for a trend comparison, however there were undertones higher. Slaughter cows sold steady, bulls \$2 higher; Demand moderate and supply light. Cows made up approximately 18 percent of the run 87 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 36 percent of the offering, 55 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 41 percent.

**SLAUGHTER BULLS:** Yield grade 1-2: Few 1675-2155 lbs, \$68.25-71, High Dressing \$75.50-80.

**REPLACEMENT COWS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-7 yrs old, 1145-1560 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$710-940. 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 1025-1435 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$495-620.

**COW-CALF PAIRS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-7 yrs old, 985-1315 lbs with 70-140 lbs calves, \$750-765 per pair. Δ
