Compared to last week 500-800 lb heifers sold \$2-10 higher, the rest sold slightly lower. 600-800 lb males sold \$5-8 higher, the rest sold \$2-4 lower. Several large groups of preconditioned feeders trended the market higher. Slaughter cows sold steady to \$1-3 higher, bulls \$1-4 higher.

BRED COWS: 4-6 yrs olds, 2nd & 3rd stage 800-1200 lbs \$850-1175. 7 aged, 2nd-3rd stage, 1000-1200 lbs \$800-1050.
