Receipts: 543; Last Week: 771; Year Ago: 635

Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold uneven, from \$2 higher to \$4 lower. Slaughter cows sold \$2 higher and bulls sold steady; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 21 percent of the run, 79 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 42 percent of the offering, 50 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 13 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 250-300 lbs \$165-170; 300-400 lbs \$159-170; 400-500 lbs \$149.50-163; 500-550 lbs \$132-138; 550-600 lbs \$122-135; few 600-650 lbs \$121-134.50. Medium 2: Few 250-300 lbs \$144-150; few 350-400 lbs \$128-136; few 400-500 lbs \$134-147; 500-600 lbs \$116-127.

FEEDER HOLSTEINS: Large 3: Pkg 675 lbs \$86.50; pkg 837 lbs \$94; pkg 989 lbs \$86.50.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 720 lbs \$110.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$66.50-72, High Dressing \$79.50-82.50; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$70.50-74, High Dressing \$76-80.50, Low Dressing \$66; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$54-60, High Dressing \$63.50-66, Low Dressing \$50.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1495-2490 lbs, Bulk \$80-86.50, High Dressing \$88-90.

STOCKER COWS: Scarce.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 3-6 yrs old 1050-1245 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage \$970-1010.
