

Illinois Wheat Summer Forum Scheduled

The Illinois Wheat Association will host a Summer Wheat Forum on Tuesday, August 23, 2011 at the Knights of Columbus Hall, 12454 State Route 143, Highland, Illinois.

The purpose of the Forum is to help wheat producers plan their fall planting. Session topics will include seeding strategies; yields and issues surrounding the 2011 Illinois wheat crop; use of genetic resistance and fungicides to control scab; a wheat crop insurance update; nitrogen sources and inhibitors for wheat; and weed management.

Registration begins at 8:00 a.m. Sessions will begin at 9:00 a.m. and the Forum will conclude at 3:30 p.m. Lunch is included.
