The Morsoy Xtra 49X10 is another new introduction that fits most soil types and has shown to be an excellent yielder.

We also offer our Morsoy line of Round-Up Ready 1 Soybeans such as the 4706 which is a great choice for lighter soils, the 5168 which is an indeterminate best suited for mixed to heavier soil types, and the 5388 which adapts to most soil types and has an excellent disease package.

As an alternative to the Round-Up Ready system, Morsoy has 2 conventional soybeans. The CB 4860 and CB 5209 are excellent yielding soybeans with good disease packages which fit most soil types.
