Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold uneven, from \$2 higher to \$7 lower on a light test due to weather. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$2 lower; Demand uneven and supply very light. Cows made up approximately 24 percent of the run, 72 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 35 percent of the offering, 52 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 26 percent.
