Receipts: 307; Last Week: 735; Year Ago: 544

Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold uneven, \$2 lower to \$3 higher. Slaughter cows sold steady and bulls sold \$1 higher; Demand uneven and supply very light. Cows made up approximately 26 percent of the run, 74 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 54 percent of the offering, 40 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 21 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 300-400 lbs \$112-118; 400-500 lbs \$98.50-113; 500-600 lbs \$87-99; few 600-675 lbs \$88.25-97; few 700-750 lbs \$82.50-88.25. Medium 2: 300-350 lbs \$105-110; 350-400 lbs \$88-95.50; pkg 560 lbs \$80.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 375-400 lbs \$96-100.50; 400-450 lbs \$94-104; 450-500 lbs \$89-100;

500-600 lbs \$84-96; 600-700 lbs \$79-86.25; 700-725 lbs \$80.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: 500-550 lbs \$89-93; 650-700 lbs \$83-87.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, \$44-46.50, High Dressing \$50; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$40.50-47.25, High Dressing \$50.50-51.75, Low Dressing \$38.50; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$32-35.50, High Dressing \$41, Low Dressing \$23.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1195-1870 lbs \$49.50-54.50, High Dressing \$56.50.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 3-7 yrs old, 845-1350 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$640-690. 8 yrs short and solid mouth, 880-1250 lbs 2nd and 3rd stage, \$400-500.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Scarce.

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
