Due to a bad storm last Friday the offering was light, however compared to last week, 500 lbs steers and heifers sold \$4 lower, the rest of the offering sold \$1-3 higher. Slaughter cows sold \$2 higher and bulls sold steady; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 13 percent of the run, 87 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 38 percent of the offering, 53 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 40 percent.
