No sale July 7 due to the Holiday. Compared to last week, steers sold steady to \$3 lower, heifers sold steady to \$4 higher. Slaughter cows sold \$1 higher and bulls sold \$3 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 17 percent of the run, 83 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 35 percent of the offering, 56 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 24 percent.
