Compared to last week, 400 lbs steers sold \$4 higher, the rest of the offering sold \$2-5 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$1 higher; Demand uneven and supply moderate. Cows made up approximately 9 percent of the run, 91 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 43 percent of the offering, 42 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 25 percent.

STOCKER COWS: Medium 2: 3-6 yrs old, 870-1040 lbs, \$61-62.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-6 yrs old, 1007-1421 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$750-1000. Few 8 yrs to short and solid, 1075-1530 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$610-750.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-5 yrs old, 1090-1810 lbs with 130-210 lbs calves, \$850-1100 per pair. Δ
