Compared to last week, steers sold \$2-6 higher, heifers sold uneven \$2 lower to \$3 higher. Slaughter cows sold \$1 higher, bulls sold \$1 lower; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 8 percent of the run, 92 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 51 percent of the offering, 47 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 20 percent.
