Due to the weather and road conditions, there was too small an offering for a trend comparison. Slaughter cows sold \$2 higher, bulls sold steady; Demand and supply light. Cows made up approximately 21 percent of the run, 79 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 41 percent of the offering, 45 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 29 percent.
FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 400-500 lbs \$101-109; 500-600 lbs \$95.50-101; pkg 805 lbs \$82; pkg 1066 lbs \$75. Medium 2: Pkg 245 lbs \$106.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 450-500 lbs \$78-87.50; 525-600 lbs \$75-83; 625-700 lbs \$73-77.50. Medium 2: Few 550-575 lbs \$75-77.
FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 595 lbs \$87.50; pkg 610 lbs \$87.50; few 700-750 lbs \$77-80.50.
SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, Scarce; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$45-49, High Dressing, \$51.75; Lean, 85-90 Percent Lean, Scarce.
SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1435-1880 lbs, bulk \$53.50-57.
REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Scarce.
