Top-Quality Heifers Offered At March 27 Sale

MT. VERNON, ILL. The 10th annual Illinois Heifer Development Program (IHDP) fallcalving bred heifer sale is fast approaching. This year's sale is on Saturday, March 27, at 1 p.m. at United Producers, Inc. in Salem, Illinois.

Twelve IHDP consignors from central and southern Illinois are offering approximately 50 high-quality, fall-calving replacement heifers. All heifers are guaranteed bred to calving ease bulls and have followed strict health and reproductive requirements. Many were artificially inseminated to top bulls of the breed. In addition, six IHDP consignors will offer approximately 25 bred cows or cowcalf pairs.

Last spring, the sale featured 24 fall-calv-

ing heifers and 45 bred cows and cow-calf pairs. Heifers grossed \$25,325 for an average of \$1,055 while the bred cow/cow-calf pair grossed \$56,025 for a sale average of \$1,273.
