The field day comes as the Highland Rim AgResearch and Education Center is celebrating its 70th anniversary. Since 1943 this center has been a key location for the development, management and curing of dark and burley tobacco. The center is also well known as a leading site for cow-calf management research.

The tours will conclude at approximately 12:30 p.m. when visitors can enjoy a complimentary lunch consisting of steak sandwich, chips, and cold drinks.
